



HOW TO AQUASCAPE

AQUASCAPING IS THE ART OF DESIGNING A NATURAL, VISUALLY BALANCED AQUARIUM LAYOUT USING PLANTS, ROCKS, WOOD, AND AQUATIC SUBSTRATES. AT AQUASSI LTD, WE HELP BEGINNERS AND ENTHUSIASTS CREATE STUNNING AQUASCAPES THAT ARE HEALTHY AND EASY TO MAINTAIN.



STEP 1: CHOOSE THE RIGHT AQUARIUM

SELECT AN AQUARIUM SIZE THAT SUITS YOUR SPACE AND EXPERIENCE LEVEL. LARGER TANKS ARE MORE STABLE AND IDEAL FOR FRESHWATER AQUASCAPING.

STEP 2: ADD AQUASCAPING SUBSTRATE

USE NUTRIENT-RICH AQUARIUM SOIL OR SUBSTRATE TO SUPPORT PLANT GROWTH. SLOPE THE SUBSTRATE FROM BACK TO FRONT TO CREATE DEPTH.

STEP 3: HARDSCAPE FIRST (ROCKS & WOOD)

ARRANGE AQUASCAPING ROCKS AND DRIFTWOOD BEFORE ADDING WATER. FOLLOW THE RULE OF THIRDS TO ACHIEVE A NATURAL LAYOUT.

STEP 4: PLANT YOUR AQUARIUM

START WITH EASY AQUARIUM PLANTS SUCH AS ANUBIAS, JAVA FERN, OR AMAZON SWORD.

PLANT DENSELY FOR A PROFESSIONAL LOOK.

Step 5: Fill & Filter Carefully

Slowly add water to avoid disturbing the layout. Install a high-quality aquarium filter and heater if required.

Step 6: Lighting & Maintenance

Use proper aquarium lighting to support plant growth. Regular trimming and water changes keep your aquascape healthy.

Aquascaping Tips from Aquassi Ltd

- Less is more – avoid overcrowding
- Use odd numbers of rocks for balance
- Choose fish that suit planted aquariums
